Prior to co-founding Elementl Power in 2022, Faherty co-founded Breakwater North, a private investment and advisory firm focused on mid-market acquisition and growth opportunities. Previously, he was a vice president at Piper Sandler, advising clients on mergers, acquisitions, divestitures, strategic transactions and capital raises in the energy sector.

Faherty began his career as an officer in the U.S. Navy, serving aboard nuclear-powered submarines. During his nine years of service, he qualified as a Nuclear Engineer aboard the USS Memphis (SSN-691) and served in Kabul, Afghanistan, with the International Security Assistance Force (ISAF). He has also served as a visiting lecturer at Cornell University.
